- ◆ At least 16 years of age
- ◆ A parishioner of Sacred Heart
- ◆ Received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist
- ◆ Attend Mass every Sunday as well as receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year
- ◆ If married, married according to laws of the Catholic Church  
Eligibility letters are obtained after meeting with Father Mahoney or Father Welsh. Please call the Rectory with your contact information and one of the priests will reach out to you to schedule a meeting.



Couples must contact the priest at least six months prior to the intended wedding date. All couples are required to attend premarital instructions in preparation for marriage.

#### **«CONFIANZA Y ESPERANZA»**

De la crisis a la esperanza. Del declive al crecimiento.

Presentamos la iniciativa «Confianza y Esperanza», un plan estratégico —y un esfuerzo concertado— para renovar la Iglesia Católica de Filadelfia durante los próximos 20 años; no gestionando el declive, sino invirtiendo en el crecimiento. Mientras otros se preguntan: «¿Debemos cerrar parroquias?», nosotros nos preguntamos: «¿Dónde necesita estar la Iglesia? ¿Y cómo necesita ser la Iglesia?».

#### **De la escucha a la acción**

La iniciativa «Confianza y Esperanza» surgió de 100 sesiones de escucha con cerca de 15.000 participantes. Lo que escuchamos es que la Iglesia de Filadelfia está preparada para el crecimiento; sin embargo, para crecer, primero debemos cambiar de una mentalidad de crisis a una de esperanza. Aquí es donde comienza la verdadera misión.

#### **Tiempos desafiantes**

A partir de 2026, la Iglesia de Filadelfia cuenta con 1,5 millones de católicos y es atendida por menos de 600 sacerdotes —unos 300 sacerdotes diocesanos activos, 150 sacerdotes diocesanos jubilados y 150 sacerdotes de órdenes religiosas—, quienes continúan ejerciendo su ministerio con generosidad. Colectivamente, se esfuerzan por satisfacer las necesidades pastorales y sacramentales de cada alma confiada a su cuidado; sin embargo, la realidad es que nuestros sacerdotes están sobrecargados. Para hacer las cosas aún más desafiantes, prevemos que hasta el 20% de estos sacerdotes alcancen la edad de jubilación en los próximos 5 años. El número de ordenaciones sacerdotales proyectadas no cubrirá este déficit en ese mismo plazo. Pero hay esperanza. «Filadelfia es resiliente. Cuando las cosas se ponen difíciles, los fuertes se ponen en marcha». A pesar de nuestros desafíos, la Iglesia de Filadelfia está en pleno auge. En nuestro seminario, actualmente tenemos más hombres en camino hacia el sacerdocio que cualquier otra diócesis del país. Y en nuestras parroquias, la asistencia a Misa creció un 7,5% tan solo en 2025. Este no es el momento de encogerse por miedo. Este es el momento de sembrar las semillas para una temporada de crecimiento. (del sitio web de la Arquidiócesis de Filadelfia)
